



Image Requirements updated 26.1.2012.

The only changes to the previous pdf file are the two e mail addresses:-

There are two types of competition entry - Print and Projected Digital Image (PDIs).

Prints - prints should be mounted with a minimum size of 300 sq. cm. on a mount with a maximum size of 50 x 40 cm. Although this is not compulsory for Internal Club competitions, you are strongly encouraged to use mount sizes of either 40 x 50 cm or 40 x 30 cm. these are the only two sizes of mount permitted at our Annual Exhibition and 40 x 50 cm is the required mount size for entry into the EAF Championships.

The following information must be **clearly shown** on the back of the mount.

CLUB - BEDFORD CAMERA CLUB

TITLE - *(CLEAR AND CONCISE)*

AUTHOR - *(A.N.OTHER)*

No identifying information may appear on the front of the print.

Print titles may be submitted via a paper entry form a week prior to the competition.

Print titles may also be submitted electronically by e mail to intcompprints@bedfordcameraclub.co.uk at the latest by midnight Friday preceding the competition. The print titles must be the same as appear on the back of the mount. You will receive a reply confirming receipt of your entry titles.

Prints should be handed in NO LATER THAN 7.15PM on the evening of the competition, for the judge to have a brief look, and placed on the respective priority pile (1st choice, 2nd choice). You will be able to collect your prints at the end of the evening.

For members without internet connection, paper entry forms will also be available.

PDIs - Image size must be no larger than 1400 pixels wide by 1050 pixels high. Images may be thinner (1400 pixels wide but less than 1050 pixels high) for letterbox formatted images, or narrower (1050 pixels high but less than 1400 pixels wide) for portrait formatted images. Images should be in sRGB colour profile and saved as a .jpg (JPEG) file at the highest quality setting.

Filenames should be of the format: **n_A B_x.jpg**

Where

n = image priority (1 or 2)

A B = Author's first and last names (separated by a space)

x = Image title

For example

1_David Hogg_Low-Level Spitfire.jpg

2_David Hogg_Chiddingford Bonfire.jpg

No commas, underscores or other punctuation characters should be included in the image title or author's name, but hyphens and apostrophes are allowed. Underscores may only be use to separate the 'Image Priority' number, the author's name and the image title.

PDI entries may be e mailed to intcomppdis@bedfordcameraclub.co.uk by midnight on the Friday preceding the competition.

PDIs may also be submitted by CD or memory stick the previous week and must be accompanied by a paper entry form.
